#### Scholarship Description

Westbank First Nation (WFN) recognizes the importance of education in the pursuit of career goals, personal development, and the building of capacity in our community.

**Ntityx Resources LP** (Ntityx) was the recipient of the Forest Products Association of Canada-Canadian Council for Aboriginal Business 2022 Indigenous Business Leadership Award and received a donation of five thousand dollars (\$5,000). Ntityx Resources LP wishes this donation to become part of an annual Scholarship for a post-secondary student interested in pursuing post-secondary education that would provide them with the skills to work for Ntityx Resources LP once they graduate. Ntityx cares for the land on which the forest tenures held by WFN are located. Caring for this land involves identifying and caring for all values, which include water, wildlife, soils, trees, among many others, and balancing that with activities that generate revenue, such as logging, all in accordance with the Seven Generation Plan.

Ntityx will strive to be the leading forestry enterprise in British Columbia in its scope and ability to provide a range of forestry benefits to the WFN Membership and broader community.

To recognize this, WFN is pleased to establish, in collaboration with Ntityx, the Ntityx Resources LP Scholarship, with a value of \$ 1,500. Subject to the provisions of Policy 2015-20 Scholarships and Bursaries, WFN will award this scholarship annually to the successful candidate.

The application deadline for this Scholarship is 4:30 p.m. Pacific Standard Time (PST) on sk'əlwístən/September 30 of each year. If September 30 falls on a weekend or statutory holiday, the closing date is extended to 4:30 p.m. PST on the next business day.

The Ntityx Resources LP Scholarship will be awarded by the end of skaytan/October each year.

#### Eligibility Criteria:

Applicants must:

- Be a WFN Member.
- Be enrolled in an Accredited Post-Secondary Institution (an accredited public post-secondary institution, a private post-secondary institution that is registered through the Private Career Training Institute Agency British Columbia, or an international post-secondary institution) and provide verification of acceptance within one (1) month of enrollment.
- Be in compliance with Policy 2015-49 Accounts Receivable.
- Complete and submit the Ntityx Resources LP Scholarship Application by 4:30 p.m. PST on September 30 (The deadline is extended to 4:30 p.m. PST on the next business day if September 30 falls on a weekend or statutory holiday.) The application must include:
  - An essay (500-word limit) that explains how the post-secondary education will assist Ntityx in fulfilling its commitments within the Seven Generation Plan; and
  - One (1) academic reference letter commenting on your capability, commitment to your studies and career goal (include names, telephone numbers and relationship/position).
